

IEEE Control Systems Society Outstanding Technical Committee Award

Award Description

Purpose

The IEEE Control Systems Society (CSS) Outstanding Technical Committee Award has been established to encourage efforts among CSS Technical Committees and to annually recognize outstanding performance by a Technical Committee in advancing the mission of the Society.

Award Details

Prize	\$1,000 and a Certificate
Funding	Funded by the IEEE Control Systems Society. The funds are provided to the winning Technical Committee with the understanding that they will be used to support a TC-related event.
Eligibility	The Technical Committee must have been active for at least one year at the time of nomination, and the TC report must have been submitted on time.
Presentation	Up to one award may be given per year. The award will be announced and presented at the annual IEEE International Conference on Control Technology and Applications (IEEE CCTA). No award will be given if a qualified candidate is not identified.

Basis for Judging

The selection committee will evaluate nominated Technical Committees based on the breadth and quality of their activities, including:

- Recruiting and engaging members
- Arranging workshops, tutorials, and special issues
- Sponsoring outstanding student paper awards
- Participating in conferences, reviewing, and organizing sessions
- Organizing other events that advance the field

Selection Committee

The award selection committee is composed of the Vice President for Technical Activities (who serves as chair) and two additional members nominated by the Board of Governors on the suggestion of the Executive Committee.
